# Effectiveness of Sustainable Budgetary Allocation of Ongkarak Subdistrict Administrative Organization, Ongkarak District, Nakornnayok Province

### **ABSTRACT**

This study was designed to investigate the effectiveness of sustainable budgetary allocation of Ongkarak Sbdistrict Administrative Organization and to compare the people's opinions toward the effectiveness of sustainable budgetary allocation. 53 members of Ongkarak Subdistict Administrative Organization comprised the sample of the study. The study instrument was a set of self-administratored questionnaires.

The collected data were analyzed by resorting to descriptive statistics.

The data analysis has brought to light the following facts:

Holistically and separately, the members of the administrative organization were of the opinion that the effectiveness of the sustainable budgetary allocation appeared to be at a high level. The top three highest mean scores were the following: shared values, personnel, and strategy. The administrative organization's members with different sexes differed in their opinions toward the sustainable budgetary allocation in that female respondents agreed with the effectiveness of the sustainable budgetary allocation to a greater degree than male respondents.
